Men's Club Handicap Policy

Posting of Scores:

NHGC members are required to post scores for all tournaments and practice rounds that they participate in. Members can post their scores on the Kiosk computer in the restaurant, or via the GHIN apps on mobile devices. It is important, with the launch of the World Handicap System, to post the score on the day play. The conditions of the day are used in calculations for handicap purposes, as well as daily updates to the players index. The maximum score for any hole is net double bogey. By entering hole by hole score the system will calculate or know where your shots are on the holes and just post the total score.

Competition Scores:

The Committee will post designated events that are to be used for Competition(C) score posting. Generally, there are six over the course of the season. This information will be posted at the Kiosk as well as in the Handicap Corner area on the website. It is the players responsibility to know their course handicap.

Penalty Scores:

The Handicap Committee will monitor score posting for compliance. Under USGA protocol, they reserve the right to add penalties. This can be a penalty score, modification of the handicap as well as other safeguards to assure a level playing field for all. The new WCH system has better built in filters to detect unusually high or low scores and these adjustments are calculated within the system.

Handicap index modification due to illness or disability.
