## **Men's Club Handicap Policy**

### **Posting of Scores:**

NHGC members are required to post scores for all tournaments and practice rounds that they participate in, via the GHIN apps on mobile devices, or at GHIN.com. It is important, with the World Handicap System, to post the score on the day of play. The conditions of the day are used in calculations for handicap purposes, as well as daily updates to the players index. The maximum score for any hole is net double bogey. By entering hole by hole score, the system will calculate or know where your shots are on the holes or just post the adjusted total score.

### **Competition Scores:**

The Committee will post designated events that are to be used for Competition(C) score posting. It is the players responsibility to know their course handicap on the day of play. **For events with printed scorecards, that handicap is to be used for that day.**

### **Penalty Scores:**

The Handicap Committee will monitor score posting for compliance. Under USGA protocol, they reserve the right to add penalties. This can be a penalty score, modification of the handicap as well as other safeguards to assure a level playing field for all. The new WCH system has better built in filters to detect unusually high or low scores and these adjustments are calculated within the system.

### **Handicap index modification due to illness or disability.**

Members may request an adjustment, based on the above. Contact a Committee member to request.
